

After months of therapy she is custom-fitted for a doggie wheelchair. Her life since then is hard to keep up with because she does not see her disability as anything that should hold her back, but lives life to the fullest. Frankie will leave an everlasting paw print on your heart.



Frankie the Walk 'N Roll Therapy Dog Visits Libby's House

is the second book in the Frankie series. Frankie's visits as a therapy dog to Libby's House, a senior assisted living, is shared from Frankie's point of view of the residents she meets and befriends. Many have Alzheimer's or dementia and through Frankie's example, she teaches children that patience, listening and understanding is what will lead to what matters most, which is love.

Our Needs When We Visit

Audiences: Typically we speak to K through 4th grade students. We have also addressed 5th and 6th graders also as the message about challenges and disabilities is a message for a universal audience. We can discuss your needs and see how we can best meet them.

We do visits in our local area of Wisconsin within about a two hour drive from our home in Elkhart Lake. The other option if you are outside of this range is that we offer Skype visits (see our free ebook on Skype visits on our website). When you book a visit with us we will do either one or two presentations lasting 30-45 minutes each. I prefer to try and do only one presentation since Frankie has gotten older, but if need be, we are happy to do two presentations as long as they are back-to-back with about a 5-10 minute break in between.

Equipment Needs: Our presentation includes a PowerPoint of slides so I will need a projector to hook up to my laptop (as well as a screen), or if you have a laptop compatible with Microsoft PowerPoint, I have a jump drive with my presentation on it. This helps save on time and makes things go a bit more smoothly, so if you have a PC computer/laptop I would appreciate that being ready when I arrive.

We will also need about a 6-foot table, which I place Frankie on so all the children in the room are able to see her.

If I am speaking to a group of 100 or more kids or in a gym or auditorium I will also need a microphone, and prefer a lavalier if it is available.

After the presentation the children will have an opportunity to walk past Frankie. Due to her age she has gotten a bit more nervous in bigger crowds, so the children won't be able to pet her, but they can walk by her. Please have the children line up and approach her one by one.

If I am able to stay in the same room and sign the books that are sold, that is ideal as well. If you wish to set up a book signing where the children come through the line for their book, we can do that too. Just please discuss that me when booking your visit so I allow time for that.

Presentation Outline

I offer a presentation that last approximately 30 minutes and a presentation that lasts approximately 40 minutes with time for Q & A at the end of each. Each presentation includes a PowerPoint of slides.

Outline for 30 minute (approx) presentation (best for K-2 or any grade if you won't want the 40 minute presentation)

~Discussion of dachshund breed

 $\sim\!$ Discussion of how Frankie's life was for the first six years of her life without her wheelchair

~Discussion of Frankie's spinal injury, how it happened, showing a diagram of a dachshund spine explaining how dogs and people spines are similar in how they work ~Discussion of the accident that caused Frankie's injury by doing a selected reading from *Frankie the Walk 'N Roll Dog*.

~Demonstration of Frankie's wheelchair. Student volunteer involvement.

~Discussion of how I help Frankie go to the bathroom because of her paralysis.

~Demonstration of physical therapy I did for Frankie. Student volunteer involvement.

~Discussion about challenges, attitude & giving back to society incorporating Frankie's

book Frankie the Walk 'N Roll Therapy Dog Visits Libby's House.

~Discussion of Frankie's therapy dog work at Libby's House

~Discussion/photos of Frankie after her injury living life to the fullest

~Discussion of how Frankie never felt sorry for herself and how she persevered.

~Discussion about challenges and how they are part of life and help us to learn and grow into better people and end with Frankie's motto: "Always be positive, make a difference, and keep on rolling!"

~Q & A

Outline for 40 minute (approx) presentation (best for 3rd and up)

~All the above for the 30 minute is included with this presentation

~Discussion of how my chocolate lab, Cassie Jo led me to become a writer after a diagnoses of terminal bone cancer and how it made me stop think about my life ~Discussion of how I became a writer because of what I learned from Cassie Jo and my first writing experiences with writing a monthly column about animals.

~Discussion of how I never thought I'd write children's books and what inspired me. ~I share a photo of my writing studio and the choice I had to make to get the studio.

Book Orders

We offer a special discount price for students to purchase our books (book order form on pg. 16). Please send book order form home two weeks in advance of our visit (**please note it is two pages**). Book orders **under 50** will be left with school day of visit. Book orders **over 50** will be shipped directly to schools (I will pay shipping). For book orders being shipped to schools, payment of books still due day of my visit. That day, or following day, order will be placed with my printing company. Expect delivery 5-10 days later (sometimes more during a holiday). Separate custom labels with my message will each be signed to student ordering book(s) and my autograph, which I will mail to school. School librarian or each classroom teacher will then just need to affix label into each book. Frankie's pawtograph is already imprinted in each book.

Note: Part of our mission is to help other animals with disabilities, so we donate a portion of all book proceeds to organizations and charities that care for these special animals.

Payment

Payment due day of my visit. If paying by check please make check to: Barbara Techel. Any books sold, payment is also due day of my visit. If children bring in money late or decide after our visit they would like a book, please contact me and I'm happy to mail book(s) to your school and I will cover the shipping.

When to Book

Our calendar fills quickly, so the sooner we can secure a date, the better. Please keep in mind that we also only schedule visits once per week. Booking at least one month out is best to build excitement for our visit and plan for the event.

Cancellations

To date, knock on wood, I have not had to cancel. But if due to illness with me or Frankie or an emergency and I would have to cancel I will do my best to reschedule as soon as possible.

Tips to Ensure a Successful Visit

- Please tell your staff– especially the office staff where it is likely I will need to sign in—that I'm coming to school, and with a dog. A smooth check in allows me to keep my wits about me and calmly guide Frankie to the room we need to set up and do our presentation.
- Please let the children know Frankie and I are coming to school. This builds excitement and anticipation of our visit.

• In fact why not get everyone involved and read the story to the students. You can visit our website, www.joyfulpaws.com and watch Frankie's inspirational video. 
